





### **Amazing Facts**

### FACT-1

The airbag in cars save your life, but they are actually made of highly toxic substance called sodium azide. The safety air bags in automobiles are inflated by nitrogen gas generated by the rapid decomposition of sodium azide ( $NaN_3$ ). CRASHES trip sensors in cars that send an electric signal to an ignitor. The heat generated causes sodium azide( $NaN_3$ ) to decompose into sodium metal and nitrogen gas, which inflates the car's air bags. Under normal circumstances, this molecule is quite stable. If heated, though, it will fall apart. The chemical equation

$$2NaN_3(s) ----> 2Na(s) + 3N_2(g)$$

Here the second product of the above reaction is  $N_2$ , also known as nitrogen gas. A handful (130 grams) of sodium azide will produce 67 liters of nitrogen gas which is enough to inflate a normal air bag.





FACT-2

Apples give off Ethylene gas that accelerates ripening. You can place unripe avocados, tomatoes and more in a bag with one apple to ripen them faster.



FACT-3 Cold Welding


If two pieces of the same type of metal touch in space, they will bond and be permanently stuck together; this amazing effect is known as cold welding. It happens because the atoms of the individual pieces of metal have no way of knowing that they are different pieces of metal, so the lumps join together. This would not happen on Earth because there is air and water separating the pieces. The effect has a lot of



implications for spacecraft construction and the future of metal-based construction in vacuums.

### FACT-4

Your body is only 11 months old because almost every cell in your body is replaced in every 11 months. Except



for brain cells which get replaced after every 7 years.

### FACT-5 Bananas are radioactive

Bananas contain potassium, and since potassium decays, that makes them slightly radioactive. But it's nothing you need to worry about. You'd need to eat 10,000,000 bananas at once to die of radiation poisoning.



### FACT-6

# It is scientifically possible to die from drinking too much water.


It's important to stay hydrated to keep our bodies functioning well. However, too much water can also be fatal. When a dehydrated person drinks too much water without the accompanying electrolytes, they can die from water intoxication and hyponatremia. In fact, forced water intake is even a known torture method.



# FACT-7 Sunflowers are known as hyperaccumulators

Like many other hyperaccumulating plants, sunflowers remove metal compounds from deep in the soil and transport them into the stem, leaves and, flower head. They can take up high concentration of toxic materials and are adept at extracting radioactive metals from a particular

place in a period of 3-4years. Hyperaccumulating plants are used to clear up waste during a process called phytoremediHypera.



### FACT-8

### The laser get trapped in a waterfall.

Just poke a hole in the side of your bottle, allowing a stream of water to smoothly shoot out, and then aim your laser through the bottle, and you'll see it get caught up in the cascading waterfall and curve downwards with it, interrupting its usually straight path. This is an example of total internal reflection, which occurs when a beam of light hits a medium boundary (the



edge of the water spout) at a particular angle, so it reflects, rather than passes straight through. This happens over and over again as the light hits each boundary, so the laser remains caught in the waterfall.

### FACT-9



# Glass is actually a liquid, it just flows very, very slowly

Being neither liquid, nor solid, explaining glass is a lot harder than some might think. In a glass, molecules still flow, but at a very low rate that it's barely perceptible. As such, it's not enough to class glasses as a liquid, but neither as a solid. Instead, chemists classify glasses as amorphous solids— a state somewhere between those two states of matter. There's also a thing called metal glass — a class of materials that are three times stronger than titanium and have the elastic modulus of bone, all while being extremely lightweight.

### FACT-10

Every hydrogen atom in your body is likely 13.5 billion years old because they were created at the birth of the universe

At ground zero, during the Universe's singularity, the very first chemical element was hydrogen. All the other followed by fusing hydrogen into helium, which then fused into carbon and so on. Approximately 73% of the mass of the visible



universe is in the form of hydrogen. Helium makes up about 25% of the mass, and everything else represents only 2%. By mass, hydrogen and helium combined make up less than 1% of the Earth.


